

Play the game with a friend.

The board game path consists of the following elements:

- Start**: A grey square at the top left.
- whales**: A circle containing the word.
- baby**: A circle containing the word.
- Move back two steps**: A circle containing the instruction.
- teeth**: A circle containing the word.
- blue**: A circle containing the word.
- world**: A circle containing the word.
- hole**: A circle containing the word.
- travel**: A circle containing the word.
- amazing**: A circle containing the word.
- swimmers**: A circle containing the word.
- mammals**: A circle containing the word.
- Finish**: A grey square at the bottom left.

Illustrations include a whale's tail fluke at the top left and a whale's head with a blowhole at the middle right.

**For the teacher:** Review the new vocabulary from *All About Whales*. Divide the children into pairs and give out dice and counters. Ask each pair to take turns rolling the dice and moving their counter that number of spaces. When they land on a word, they must say the word and then put it into a sentence.
